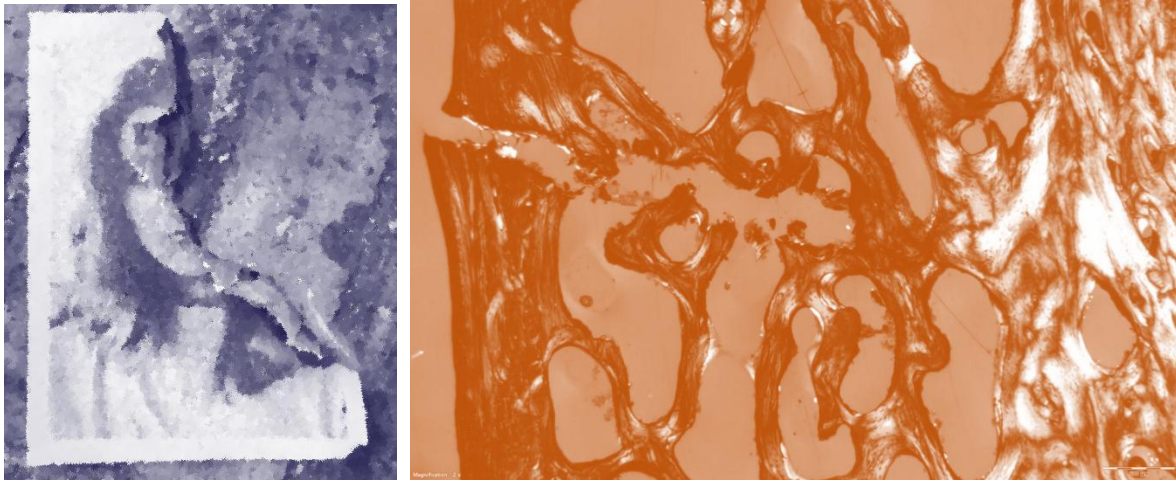


FASE symposium in Paris August 30th
